I have not been making posters since morning.

Sub+ **has not been** + Base form of the verb+ ing+ Extra word

Sara has not been making posters for tow hours.

Interrogative:

Have+ Sub+ **been**+ Base form of the verb+ ing+ Extra word

Have i been making posters since morning.

Has+ Sub+ **been** + Base form of the verb+ ing+ Extra word

Has Sara been making posters for tow hours.

For use: Whole period of time **since use: Past starting point**
