

Conditionals

Zero Conditional

If + Present Simple, Present Simple

If weather is nice, I go to the beach.

Use: To talk about things that are always true like a scientific.

First Conditional

If + Present Simple, Simple future

If I go to London, I will post for him.

Use: To talk about possibilities in the present or in the future.

Second Conditional

If + Past Simple, Present Conditional

If he got a job, he would buy a car

Use: Imaginary situations in the present or future.

Third Conditional

If + Past Perfect, Perfect Conditional

If she had read the news, she would have got that prize.

Use: Imaginary situations in the past .

Hypothetical

If + Past Perfect, Present Conditional

If he had been there, he wouldn't be save.

Use: Present result of a past condition.

Not possible Now

If + Past simple, Perfect Conditional

If I were a doctor, I would have been in hospital.

Use: Past result of a present or continuing condition.

Note:

Present Conditional: would\wouldn't + First Verb form

Perfect Conditional: would\wouldn't + have + Past Participle
