مَا ظَنُّكَ؟

(ma zanno ka)

What do you think?

نَهَارُكَ سَعِيدٌ

(naharoka sa'edin)

Have a nice day.

هَذَا أَمْرٌ مُسَلَّمٌ بِهِ

(haza amron mosallimon bihi)

It's an indisputable matter.

هَذَا لَا يَعْْنِيكَ فِي شَيْءٍ

(haza la yanika fi shaien)

It has nothing do with you.



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سِيَّانَ عِنْدِي

(siyaana e'ndi)

It is all the same for me.

مَهْمَا كَانَتْ الْأَحْوَالُ

(mahama kanatil aHwalo)

Whatever the case may be.

إِعْتَمِدْ عَلَيَّ

(e'tamid e'alaiya)

Trust me.
