What is your name?

(ismi Ali)

My name is Ali.

مَا إِسْمُ وَالِدِكَ؟

(ma ismo walidika)

What is your father name?

إِسْمِي وَالِدِي نُور

(ismi walidi moor)

My father name is Noor.

كَمْ عُمْرُكَ؟

(kam umroka)

What is your age?

عُمْرِي عِشْرُونَ سَنَةً

(umri eshrona sanaton)

My age is twenty years.

مَا هِيَ جِنْسِيَّتُكَ؟

(ma hiya jinsiyatoka?)

What is your nationality?

أَنَا مَكِّي

(aana makki)

I am makki.

Where you live?

أَسْكُنُ فِي مَكَّةَ

(askono fi makka)

I live in Makka.

هَلْ عِنْدَكَ أَوْلَادٌ؟

Do you have children?

نَعَمْ: عِنْدِي ثَلَاثَةُ أَوْلَادٍ

(na'em: e'ndi salasaton awladi)

Yes: I have three children.
